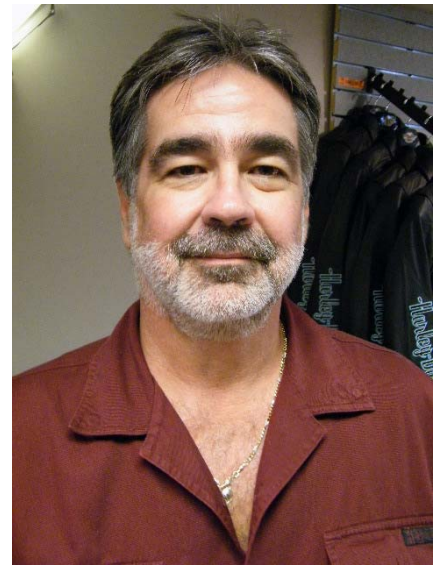
# Speaking Directly

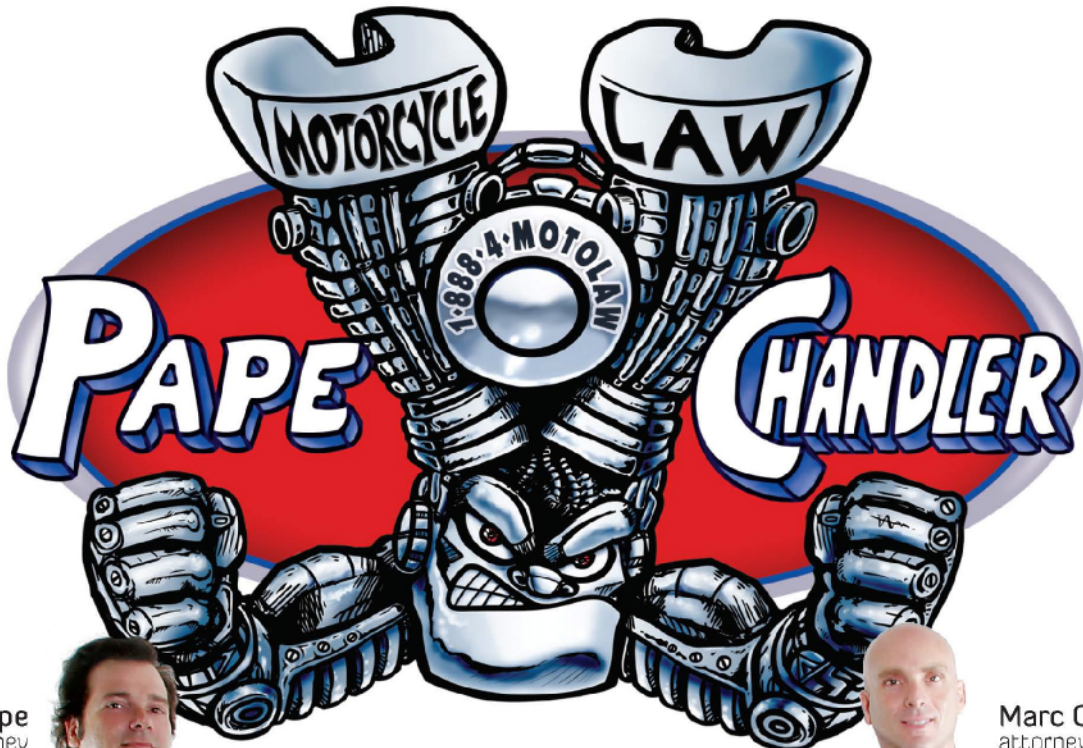

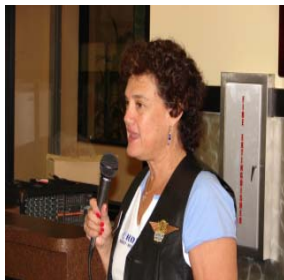

# Safety Article:

## Safety is something to strive for

Sometimes it is not what we do; sometimes it's our environment.

You can be the safest rider of all time and outside forces take over.

You can't prepare for all circumstances.

This morning I was on my way to the dealer since it was time for the 45,000 mile checkup. I only use Harley dealers do any work on my Limited and Barb's Triglide. This is with good reason.

This past summer Barb and I rode our bikes for a combined 20,000 miles (Barb on her trike some 5,200 miles). Barb rode from Coral Springs to Chicago, then to Caribou, Maine and back to Coral Springs. Look for the details in Barb's article. But I digress. On the way home, Barb's trike began to give us some electrical problems of the worst type. It all started in Maine as we were preparing for the trip home. The trike would not start, so we had to give it a jump. We made it all the way to New Jersey. The following morning the trike wouldn't start. At that point we knew we had a real problem.

We found a Harley dealer 30 miles from the hotel, Barb's Harley Davidson in Ephraim New Jersey. To sum it up: great people, new battery, new regulator and we were on our way. This time we made it to Charleston, South Carolina, but the stator on the trike was gone. This destroyed the regulator and the battery. We had to take the trike to Low Country Harley Davidson, where we met by some great people.

Here they replaced the battery, the regulator and the stator. Luckily, we only had to pay for the stator and labor. Harley covered the battery and the regulator. Just imagine having this work done at some NO NAME motorcycle shop, and then imagine asking them to honor another shop's work. It would never have happened.

This type of service can only be had when you go to a Harley Davidson Dealership. So, when you need work done on your ride, go to your dealer. They are your support and in turn, you need to support them.

Make sure you have your bike properly serviced before you go on your next trip. See you all at the State Rally.

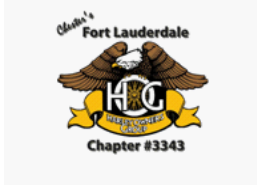

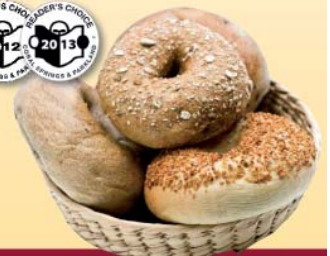

## IMPORTANT CHAPTER RIDE POLICIES



In the event that inclement weather interferes with our scheduled rides, please be advised of our long-standing policy regarding cancellation of a ride. While it is always a member's option to go on a chapter ride whenever we have inclement weather, a decision will be made by the Lead Road Captain whether the SANCTIONED ride will take place. Riding in inclement weather is a safety issue we should always consider. The formal cancellation of a ride will occur at the time and place the ride begins. The Lead Road Captain running the ride will be present at the designated time and place the ride begins to advise those present of the decision.

While the HOG Ft. Lauderdale Chapter #3343 always promotes riding, we have a responsibility to our members, H.O.G. National, our sponsoring Dealer and Harley-Davidson. All participants in our rides must be a current member of H.O.G. National and our local Chapter. All members are issued a local membership card that must be shown at the time of the ride. If the card is not available, a waiver must be signed prior to the ride. Guests are allowed on up to 3 rides and must sign a waiver prior to each ride. At the 3rd ride, Guests will be asked to become a member. Participants without membership cards or signed waivers will not be allowed to participate in any Chapter events. Guests are not allowed to participate in the fourth event. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.

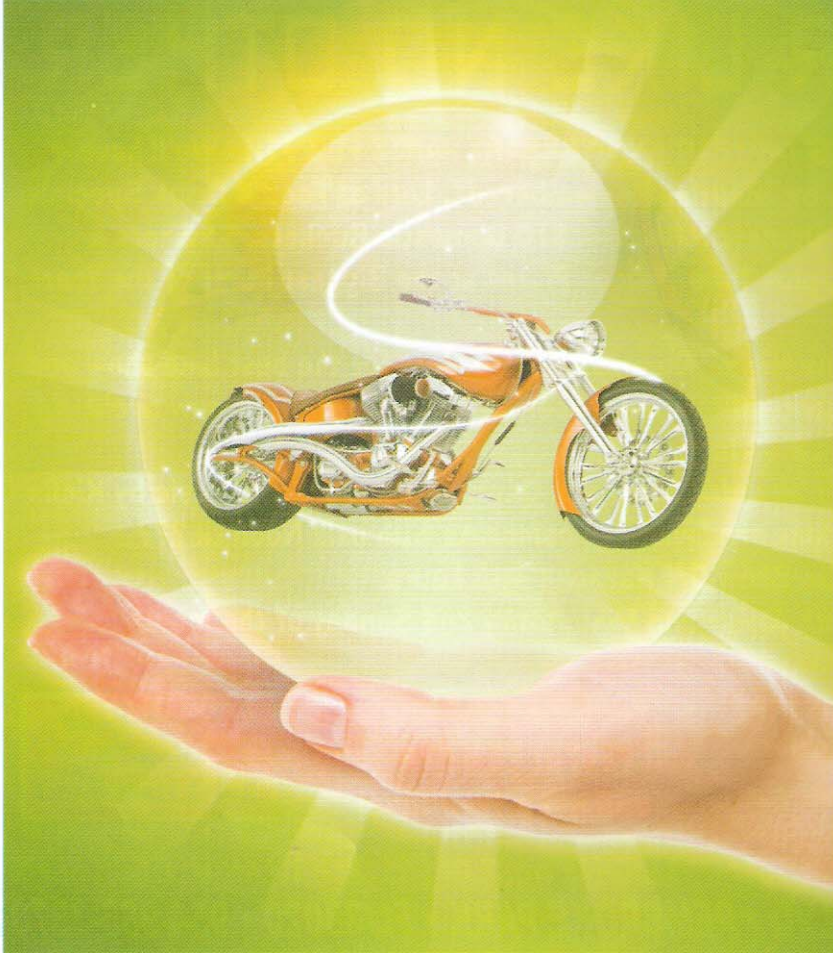
