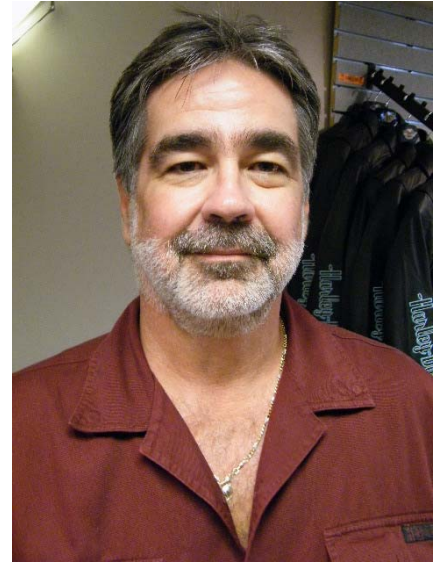
THE PRIME DIRECTIVE or Why we love our Harley's

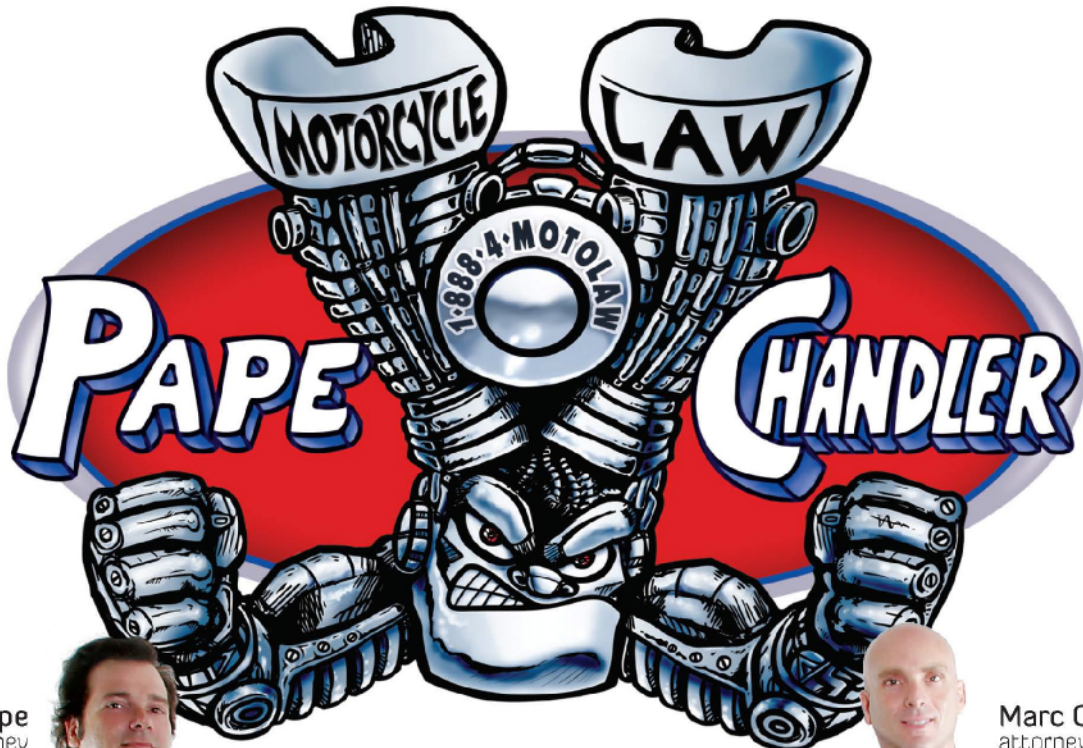

Safety Article: ENGINE BRAKING OR NO ENGINE BRAKING?

When I'm coming to a stop, should I let out the clutch between shifts, using the engine braking in addition to the brakes to help me slow down? Of the guys I ride with, some say this is a great technique, but others insist I'm wearing out my clutch or transmission.

Engine braking can help slow you down from higher speeds, but the technique has an advantage even at lower speeds. Because you're downshifting as you slow, you'll be in the right gear in case you need to make a quick move (such as accelerating away from a tailgater) or in case the light changes to green before you come to a complete stop. If you were in high gear and simply held the clutch lever in while braking to a stop, you would be spending extra time making several downshifts to reach the right gear for accelerating quickly.

If you're slowing using only engine braking, be sure to use a light tap of your foot on the brake lever to actuate the brake light and alert those behind you.

You should not worry about damaging the transmission. As long as the clutch is disengaged when you shift, the transmission does not care whether you're doing a normal downshift or a downshift related to engine braking.

However, it is true you might wear the clutch out slightly sooner from frequent engine braking, because the clutch will be spending more time in the friction zone, but if you want to consider that "damage" or normal wear that is up to you. You can minimize the time spent in the friction zone by doing a quick throttle blip to bring the revs up a bit before releasing the clutch lever.

Finally, some riders simply like the additional feeling of being in control that engine braking can provide.

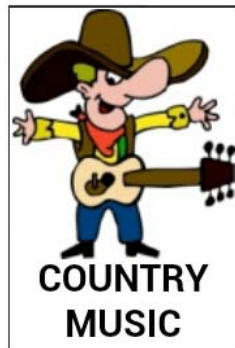

IMPORTANT CHAPTER RIDE POLICIES



In the event that inclement weather interferes with our scheduled rides, please be advised of our long-standing policy regarding cancellation of a ride. While it is always a member's option to go on a chapter ride whenever we have inclement weather, a decision will be made by the Lead Road Captain whether the SANCTIONED ride will take place. Riding in inclement weather is a safety issue we should always consider. The formal cancellation of a ride will occur at the time and place the ride begins. The Lead Road Captain running the ride will be present at the designated time and place the ride begins to advise those present of the decision.

While the HOG Ft. Lauderdale Chapter #3343 always promotes riding, we have a responsibility to our members, H.O.G. National, our sponsoring Dealer and Harley-Davidson. All participants in our rides must be a current member of H.O.G. National and our local Chapter. All members are issued a local membership card that must be shown at the time of the ride. If the card is not available, a waiver must be signed prior to the ride. Guests are allowed on up to 3 rides and must sign a waiver prior to each ride. At the 3rd ride, Guests will be asked to become a member. Participants without membership cards or signed waivers will not be allowed to participate in any Chapter events. Guests are not allowed to participate in the fourth event. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.

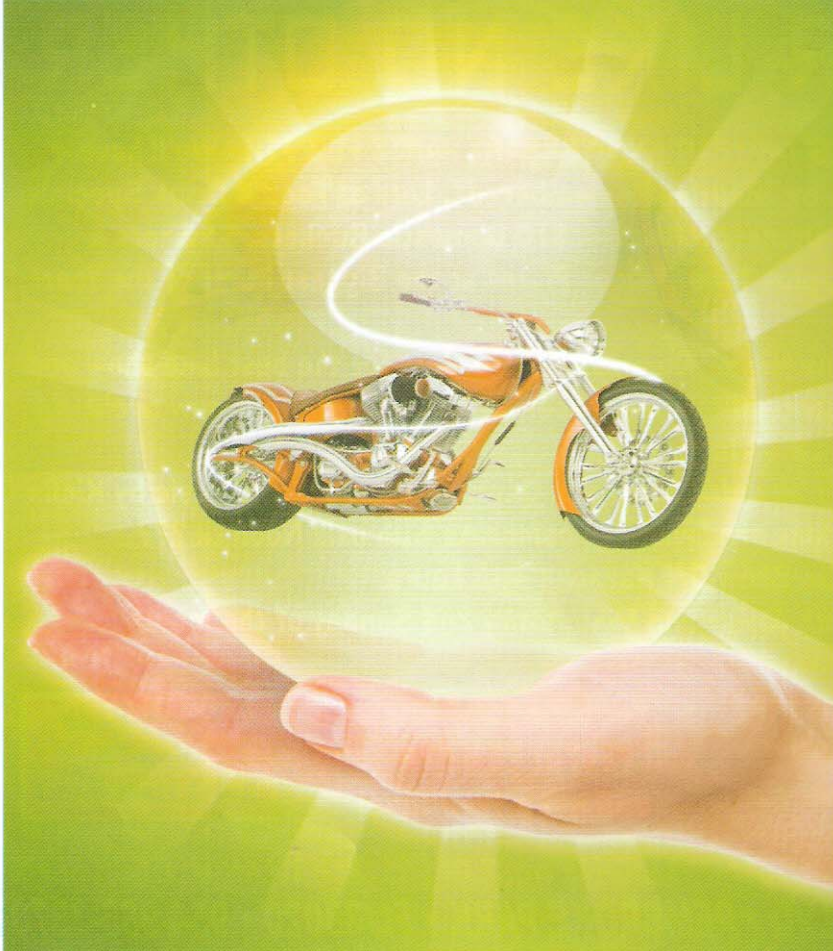
