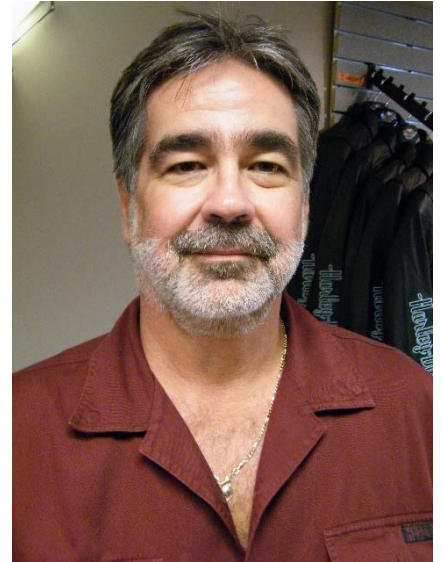

Safety Article:

SPEED CONTROL - Engine Braking

When you are cruising on the interstate highway speed is pretty much controlled by the throttle and when you are making that tight u-turn to find a parking space we control speed by using coordination of the clutch, throttle and rear brake. But what about those sweeping curves through the hills and on and off ramps? What about those quick switchbacks in the mountains or that long climb or decent from the mountains back into the hill country? The technique for taking a curve is still slow, look, press and roll – “slipper”, but how we execute the technique may be slightly different.

Setting up for a turn means picking your path and reducing your speed before leaning the motorcycle. Why? Speed control minimizes the need for braking while leaned over in the turn.

SLIPPER

Slow means to slow on the straight away prior to the turn, slowing slow enough that you can gently roll on the throttle from the beginning of the turn to the end of the turn maintaining or gently increasing speed throughout. We recommend slowing using both brakes so your brake light gives other motorists a heads up but engine braking also slows you down.

Look means to look through your path of travel keeping your head and eyes up so you can plan your approach to the next curve. Setting up a lane position for an outside-inside –outside (O-I-O) path, looking through and ahead to where you want to end up.

Press means to press the handle bar into the direction of the turn and maintaining the down and outward pressure to keep your intended path. Like the steering wheel on your car you have to press into the turn as it gets tighter. Your motorcycle will lean to about 33 degrees from the road surface. Barring no other factors, if you maintain or gently increase power to the rear wheel, look through the turn and plan an O-I-O path you can make any turn on the U.S. highway system without incident.

Roll means to maintain or gently accelerate all the way through your turn. By gently rolling on the throttle the weight of the motorcycle is shifted to the rear compressing the rear shock absorbers and “sticking” the rubber

to the road giving you good traction and responsive handling. SLIPPER - it works.

Engine Braking mean down shifting and easing out the clutch and letting the lower gear slow the motorcycle. Many of us use engine braking when coming to a stop sign but how about for taking curves? In the sweepers and switchbacks power is your friend. You want your bike to be immediately responsive to your operating needs. You might be throwing the handlebar pressure right and left, accelerating and decelerating quickly as you navigate a challenging windy road. For that we recommend operating your bike at a lower gear with higher rpms for better speed control. At a lower gear and higher rpm a simple roll off of the throttle causes engine braking while a roll on of the throttle will cause a quick responsive acceleration making reaction time faster, allowing you to focus on the look and press elements of your cornering. While running at a lower gear and higher rpms you are less dependent on the brakes for slowing and we all know braking while in a curve can compromise your traction.

IMPORTANT CHAPTER RIDE POLICIES



In the event that inclement weather interferes with our scheduled rides, please be advised of our long-standing policy regarding cancellation of a ride. While it is always a member's option to go on a chapter ride whenever we have inclement weather, a decision will be made by the Lead Road Captain whether the SANCTIONED ride will take place. Riding in inclement weather is a safety issue we should always consider. The formal cancellation of a ride will occur at the time and place the ride begins. The Lead Road Captain running the ride will be present at the designated time and place the ride begins to advise those present of the decision.

While the HOG Ft. Lauderdale Chapter #3343 always promotes riding, we have a responsibility to our members, H.O.G. National, our sponsoring Dealer and Harley-Davidson. All participants in our rides must be a current member of H.O.G. National and our local Chapter. All members are issued a local membership card that must be shown at the time of the ride. If the card is not available, a waiver must be signed prior to the ride. Guests are allowed on up to 3 rides and must sign a waiver prior to each ride. At the 3rd ride, Guests will be asked to become a member. Participants without membership cards or signed waivers will not be allowed to participate in any Chapter events. Guests are not allowed to participate in the fourth event. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.
